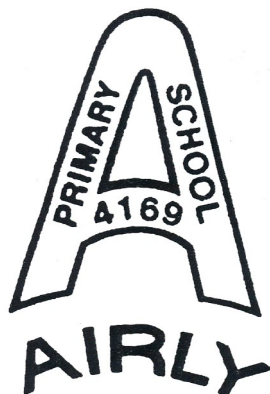

Swimming

Tomorrow, Wednesday, October 15th, all students will start swimming lessons at Aqua Energy in Sale over the next 8 weeks.

Teachers will drive students to the pool and parents are to collect them from the pool at 3:00pm.

Students will need to have their bathers and towels in a sturdy, waterproof bag (separate to their school bag).

The cost for the swimming program this year is \$113.00 per student. The estimated cost that was a part of the excursion levy was \$80.00. Mrs. Kincaid has gone into check each family's account and all are okay to cover the increased cost.

The increase is due to the lower number of students, as we still require 2 qualified instructors for the 2 different levels of swimming classes.
