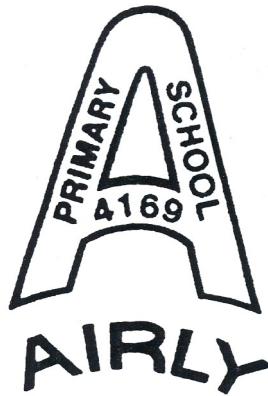

KODABLE

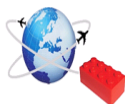

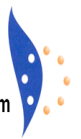
